The Office of Field Operations (OFO) has recently confirmed that some ports of entry (POE) continue to admit citizens of Canada and Mexico who are applying for entry to the United States under the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) for a maximum of one year.

According to 8 C.F.R. § 214.6 (d)(2) and § 214.6 (d)(3) of the NAFTA agreement, Citizens of Canada and Mexico seeking temporary entry as a TN nonimmigrants to engage in business activities at a professional level shall make an application for admission with a Customs and Border Protection officer at a designated port-of-entry or at a United States pre-clearance/pre-flight station. The alien, if admissible will be admitted as a TN nonimmigrant for up to three (3) years.
